

## Socially Distanced Games Night In Guidance

With government guidance about the pandemic constantly changing, we appreciate it can be difficult keeping up to speed with what you can and can't do as well as how to stay safe if you are planning to host a Games Night In in person – that's where we can help!

It's important that you make sure your event complies with social distancing guidelines in your area.

There are different guidelines in place for different areas and these include on the number of people who can meet up (both indoors and outdoors) and what represents a safe distance to stay apart. So, it is important to check the rules for your area.

Social distancing rules may change again so, closer to your event, please check [government guidance on social distancing](#) as well as any rules determined by the Governments of [Scotland](#), [Wales](#) and [Northern Ireland](#) where applicable for updates.

[Face coverings](#) can help us protect each other and reduce the spread of the disease if you are in an enclosed space where social distancing is difficult and where you will come into contact with people you do not normally meet.

You should avoid physically exchanging items like money wherever possible. For example, ask friends and family to donate to your Virgin Money Giving page rather than donating cash. Your guests will be able to donate securely online.

It's also important for you and your guests to maintain good sanitation practices. This includes regularly washing hands for 20 seconds, using hand sanitizer where soap and water isn't available.
